G8 Hokkaido Toyako Summit

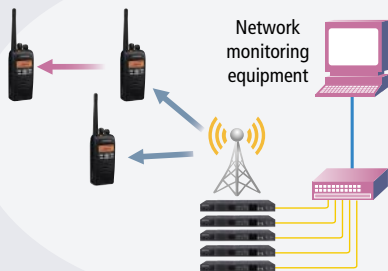
